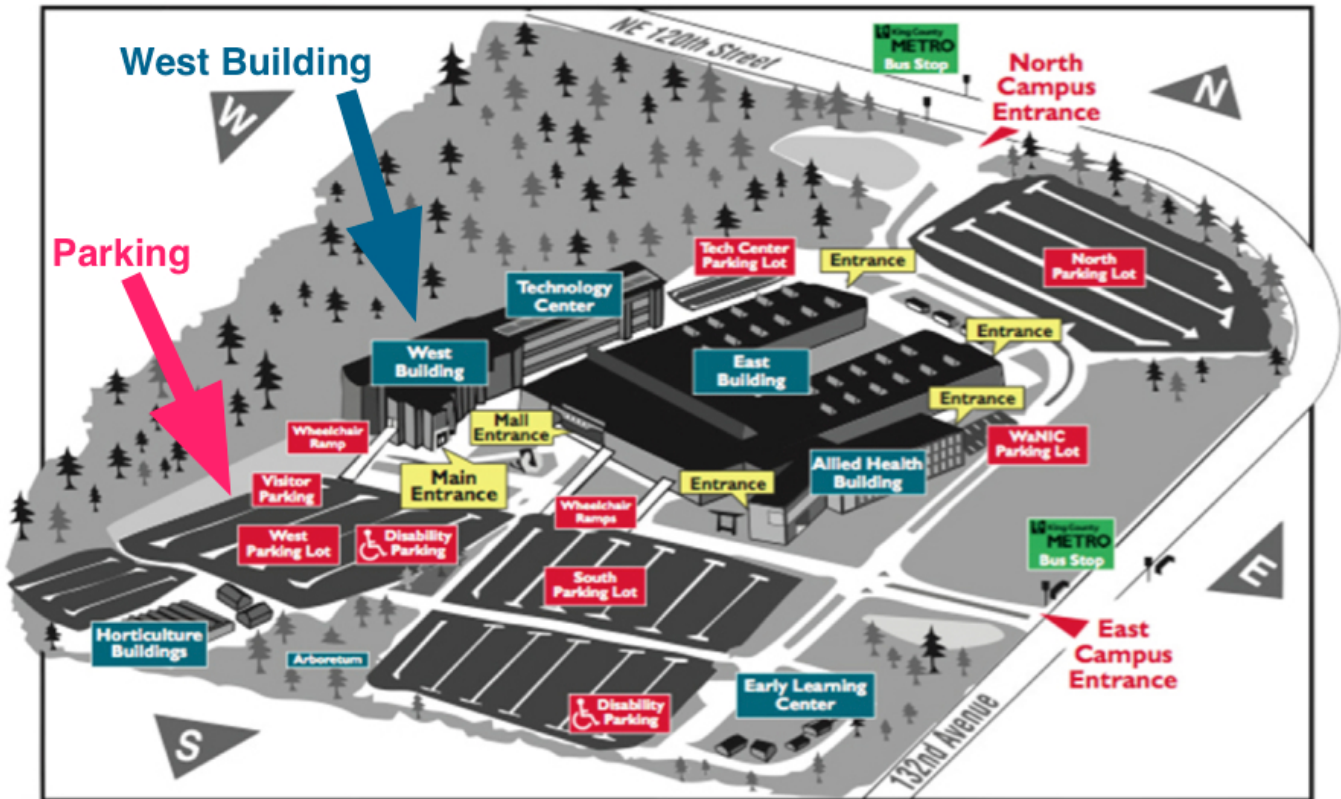
**From Northbound I-405**

**Head north** on I-405, **take exit 20A** (NE 116th Street).  
**Turn right** (east) toward Redmond onto NE 116th Street and through the stoplight.  
**Take a slight left** onto Slater Road NE.  
**Turn right** onto NE 120th Street. NE 120th Street turns onto 132nd Ave NE.  
College entrance will be on the right.

**From Southbound I-405**

**Head south** on I-405, **take exit 20** (124th St).  
**Turn left** on NE 124th Street at end of exit ramp. Go over the freeway.  
At the **third stoplight** (Totem Lake Blvd) **turn right**.  
At the **first stoplight**, **turn left** onto 120th Street.  
Go through light (Slater Ave) and up the hill.  
The college is on your right.
